NON-DENOMINATIONAL SCHOOL

FreedomProject Academy is a non-denominational classical school anchored firmly in Judeo-Christian values.

Our courses are biblical in worldview and promote biblical understandings of knowledge and truth. We do not promote the theology of any particular church, temple, or branch of Judeo-Christian thought. We work to inspire biblically-based Judeo-Christian values in the classroom, allowing parents to teach their particular faith traditions and beliefs at home.



ACADEMIC TRACKS

FPA offers a variety of academic tracks. While maintaining the trusted LIVE online courses upon which FPA has built its reputation for academic excellence, ANYTIME ACADEMY courses and independent studies (HOMESCHOOL) are also available.

ANYTIME ACADEMY has proven to be a viable option for students who:

- Are unable to attend live classes due to scheduling conflicts with time zones, locations, live class enrollment periods, and/or sports or other extra-curricular activities.
- Desire flexibility for due dates and deadlines.
- Have a medical condition or developmental delays that require modified pacing of coursework.
- Prefer a mix of LIVE classes and ANYTIME classes.

Students attending ANYTIME ACADEMY courses simply view recorded video lessons of content instruction instead of attending classes live. Homework, quizzes, and tests are submitted in a self-paced manner, and all assigned coursework must be completed by the end of June.

Assignments are a mixture of auto-scored and submitted written work graded by advisors, which may affect course progress and pacing. This is to ensure students are understanding concepts before learning new material. In addition, weekly access to live advisors is available to ANYTIME ACADEMY students.

A grade is issued upon course completion if a student successfully finishes all required coursework. Over the next few years, FreedomProject will be making most current LIVE courses available on the ANYTIME ACADEMY platform for students to complete the same course content with a greater degree of built-in flexibility.

FPA'S HOMESCHOOL TRACK COURSES

FreedomProject Academy is committed to offering families alternatives that fit the unique needs of each child. Homeschool is a program option that provides the combination of instructional engagement in recorded lesson content with parent-determined pacing and assignment adjustments as needed.

This track is designed for parents who desire a more traditional homeschool-type program, which allows for the greatest flexibility in homework and may be beneficial for students who have special needs or a busy schedule of activities. Parents serve as the teacher of record and are responsible for monitoring student progress, providing feedback, and grading any student work. Homeschool allows the student to go at a pace that promotes success and builds confidence by focusing on learning rather than due dates/deadlines. For a student who needs accommodations for pacing, this track eliminates the pressure of grades and due dates and can encourage progress that often leads to success as a regular status student.



WHAT IS A HOMESCHOOL TRACK?

A student on the Homeschool track will have a 12 month access period during which he or she may watch the recorded lessons and choose to complete any of the homework assignments or auto-graded work in Canvas. Any written work the parent chooses to have the child complete offline will be reviewed independently by the parent or other designated adult.

The child will NOT turn in any written work to be graded by FPA's faculty, thus being free of any due dates. It is up to the parent or designee to correct and grade the child's written homework and issue any grades to the student (i.e., homeschool report card).

It is the parent's or designee's responsibility to keep a record of the grades and to fulfill all state reporting requirements. There will be NO final grade issued by FPA.

This essentially becomes an independent study completed at the child's own pace using FPA's curriculum, lessons, and associated assignments. Parents are responsible for ALL academic recordkeeping.



ADULT ENRICHMENT PROGRAM

Adult Enrichment offers adult learners, non-traditional students, and people who have already earned degrees, the opportunity to audit FPA's courses as an opportunity to continue learning.

Adult Enrichment serves as a vital lifeline to continuous learning, successful citizenship, personal growth, and gainful employment.

Adult Enrichment in FPA's classical curriculum provides an opportunity for valued instruction that may have been absent in one's previous educational experience.

Adults who enroll in FPA's courses will have 10-month access to the lesson content videos, assignments, quizzes, and tests and may progress through the course at their own pace. These Adult Enrichment courses are noncredit-bearing, nontranscribed, and nontransferable to any elementary, secondary, or higher education institution. The courses are intended for personal enrichment only.

Each course costs \$500.





LIVE COURSES

How much work is expected in **LIVE** courses?



GRADE PRE-K (LIVE)

- 2-3 hours of live instruction per week
- Average homework: 1-2 hours per day (Monday - Friday)
- 10-12 total hours of class and homework per week



GRADES K-5 (LIVE)

- Two hours of live instruction per day (Monday - Thursday)
- Average homework: 3-4 hours per day (Monday - Friday)
- 23-28 total hours of class and homework per week



GRADE 6 (LIVE)

- Math and English meet four days per week (M/T/W/TH) for 50 minutes each class period
- Science and History meet two days per week (M/W or T/TH) for 50 minutes each class period
- Average homework for Math and English: about 4 hours per course each week
- Average homework for Science and History: about 3 hours per course each week
- 25-30 total hours of class and homework per week (based on four courses per week)



GRADES 7-12 (LIVE)

- English, Math, Science, History, and Electives meet two days per week (M/W or T/TH) for 50 minutes each class period
- Math courses have the option of four days per week (M/T/W/TH) for 50 minutes each class period

- Average homework 3-5 hours per course each week
- 35-40 total hours of class and homework per week (based on five courses per week)



GRADES 6-12 (ANYTIME)

- Anytime Academy class recordings will cover curriculum and content equivalent to the live classes for each course or subject (the length and number of recordings may vary by course).
- Students may work through the modules in Canvas at their own pace but should expect the lesson content and homework to be equal to that of a full year/36-week class.
- Average homework for Grade 6 Math and English: about 3-5 hours per course each week. About 15-20 total hours of content recordings and homework per week.
- Average homework for Grade 6 Science and History: about 3 hours per course each week. About 10-15 total hours of content recordings and homework per week.
- Average class time and homework for a 6th grade student enrolled in all Anytime classes is about 25-30 hours per week.
- Average homework in grades 7-12 for all Anytime courses: 3-5 hours per week/module; 35-40 total hours of class and homework per week/module (based on four or five courses)
- Homework and tests may be completed at the student's own pace, but all must be submitted within the completion window with respect to advisor grading of the course offering in order for grades to be issued.
- Graded submissions will be scored within 24-72 hours, unless submitted on a weekend.

CLUBS

FPA offers various co-curricular clubs that typically meet on Fridays (non-school day) for a semester in fall, spring, or the summer term. Club participation is completely voluntary. Examples of clubs that have been offered include: Newspaper; Robotics; Programming; Engineering; Artificial Intelligence; American Sign Language; Build and Fly A Drone; Spanish; Auto Mechanics; Raising Chickens, Ducks, & Turkeys; Drama, Nuclear Science; and more!



Family Tutoring

K-5: \$225/Family (Optional)

6-12: \$225/Family (Optional)

FPA offers two optional Family Tutoring Packages for K-12 students in various subjects including: English, math, and science. Group tutoring sessions meet every Friday throughout the school year.

If a family has one or more students in both K-5 and 6-12, and would like tutoring for both levels, both packages must be purchased.



One-on-One Tutoring

\$50/Hour (Optional)

FPA offers one-on-one tutoring for all grades and subjects. Spots must be reserved online.



Academic Advising

Upon enrollment and payment of the \$250 non-refundable application fee, FPA will assign an academic advisor for each family. The advisor will serve as a point of contact for enrollment assistance, information sharing, and to answer any questions families may have about transitioning to FPA's program successfully. The advisor will serve as the family's contact person for the duration of their time at FPA.



Tuition Assistance

FreedomProject Academy offers a tuition assistance program for eligible families in need of financial help. An application process provides detailed information about the financial need of each applicant. These reports help our Tuition Assistance Committee determine which students are eligible for tuition assistance and to what degree.

To be eligible, all returning students must have passed all courses.

Tuition Loan

For the convenience of families, FreedomProject Academy offers a loan payment plan option for EACH FAMILY enrolled in a minimum of two classes. (All K-5 students are eligible, since all subjects are included within the purchase of each course.) This allows families to pay back the tuition loan using 8 consecutive monthly payments.

A \$350 down payment for EACH STUDENT will automatically be withdrawn from a family's Tuition Management account on August 2, 2024. **The down payment is non-refundable.** No subsequent monthly fee will be assessed. (Detailed payment plan structures are available at fpeusa.org). There is a convenience fee charged if paying by credit or debit card. No extra fees are assessed if paying by checking or savings account.



Refund Policy

(Live Courses) + (Anytime Courses)

Full payment will be withdrawn on August 2. Families have until August 5 to claim a full refund. After that time, a family can withdraw up until 4 p.m. on the Friday before the first day of school and receive a **50% refund on tuition**. No refunds will be issued once the first day of school commences or students complete at least one week of an Anytime course.



Tuition Loan Refund Policy

(Live Courses) + (Anytime Courses)

A \$350 non-refundable tuition payment will be withdrawn from a family's Tuition Management account on August 2. Following that time, the payment plan may be cancelled up until 4 p.m. on the Friday before the first day of school.

After that time, families are responsible for ALL committed monthly payments for the full academic year regardless of enrollment status. (i.e. student withdraws or audits).



Textbooks

FPA goes to great lengths to ensure that textbooks are free from Common Core, are factually accurate, contribute to a classical education, and embody the values central to our program.

- FPA does not supply textbooks for students. FPA's partnership with book providers has made the process of ordering books simple and convenient for parents.
- Books must be ordered at least 3 weeks prior to the start of the school year.
- Any materials not secured prior to school starting will not be provided by FPA **nor** will extensions on work be granted until books arrive. It is a family's responsibility to ensure students have all required books and materials prior to the first day of school.



Placement Testing

Due to extreme disparities in academic preparation among enrolling students, FreedomProject Academy requires all new students to complete placement tests. These tests are essential in helping us determine the appropriate grade level and academic curriculum for a student.

Prospective Pre-K and Kindergarten students complete a live online readiness screening with a teacher. First-time students entering grades 1 through 5 must complete math and reading exercises as part of a live online measure of academic readiness skills and submit a handwriting sample to ensure they have the foundation to be successful in FPA. Families will have **ONE MONTH** from the time of enrollment to schedule a placement test in grades Pre-K-5. Placement testing ends on July 30, 2024.

If a placement test is not scheduled by the deadline, the student's reserved spot in a course will be released. A \$25 fee will be applied to a family's tuition account if a scheduled placement test is missed. First-time students in grades 6 through 12 are required to complete written placement tests in math as well as grammar, reading comprehension, and writing. Some science courses and second or third-year foreign language courses also require placement testing for first-time enrollment. FPA will only enroll students in courses for which they show proficiency through their placement testing.

Students in grades 6 through 12 will have **ONE MONTH** from the time of enrollment to submit required placement tests. The final date for placement test submission is July 30, 2024. If the placement tests are not received by the deadline, the student's reserved spot in the course will be released.

Any RETURNING STUDENT who must complete a placement test or screening based on requested courses or grade level advancement must do so by June 30, 2024.

Important: Placement Testing will be administered AFTER the student has applied to FreedomProject Academy and has paid the \$250 application fee. Placement testing must be completed before FPA can confirm enrollment in any courses.

DECISIONS BASED ON PLACEMENT TEST RESULTS ARE FINAL.

Cursive Writing

Students in courses from Pre-K through the first semester of second grade are taught manuscript writing (printing). Students from the beginning of the second semester of second grade through fifth grade are taught cursive writing. As students become fluent in cursive beyond third grade, teachers will regularly assign work that is required to be handwritten in cursive.

FPA requires all students from grades 6 through 12 to use cursive writing when submitting most handwritten assignments. These assignments must be legible and will not be accepted if printed or typed. To assist students who have not learned cursive writing or are not proficient, FPA provides the following timeline for your student(s) to learn and practice cursive writing. For the first quarter, the student will be exempt from cursive but must use this time to learn and practice legible cursive writing. At the start of the second quarter, one half of each handwritten assignment will be expected to be submitted in legible cursive. Beginning in the second semester, all handwritten assignments will be expected to be written entirely in cursive.

Literature

The literature students read at FPA is selected to expose students to a range of voices as they encounter the great books of Western Civilization. Regardless of the content of each book, the books will be taught from a biblical worldview and contribute to a wide variety of perspectives that will give a basis to understand how Western Culture has been shaped.




Grades

All graded material is available in Canvas for students and their parents to access 24/7. When a teacher grades an assignment, quiz, or test, a notification is sent to the student's newsfeed in Canvas.

Teachers have the ability to digitally mark up papers and attach a recorded video or audio comments to graded material, if they so choose. Students use a unique login to access their accounts and submit work for LIVE and ANYTIME courses.

The administration and teachers of FreedomProject Academy are steadfast in our efforts to provide an excellent education for our students.

This requires vigilance, as practices and trends promoting mediocrity and low standards abound in government schools and all kinds of private schools. Excellence in education begins with an evaluation of the student's independently completed work and responsiveness to feedback provided.



The recent trend of resubmitting assignments after receiving teacher feedback leads to better grades but is not an accurate evaluation of a student's independent skill level. This practice stems from Common Core/ No Child Left Behind/Outcome-Based Education, which puts the emphasis on grades (outcome).

An excellent education is focused on learning and the student's growth, not just outcome. Our grading policy is designed to promote learning and student growth. For clarity, once an assignment is submitted, no resubmission will be accepted unless multiple attempts are allowed on such assignment. Much effort is taken to grade and provide feedback.

It is the parent's responsibility to review graded assignments with the child for the purpose of learning from mistakes. This permits the parent and teacher to direct the growth of each child with accurate knowledge.



Academic Probation

All students at FPA will be expected to maintain a 2.0 GPA. Failure to maintain a 2.0 GPA will result in Academic Probation. See website and handbook for complete details.



Audit Status

FreedomProject Academy is committed to offering families alternatives that fit the unique needs of each child. Audit status is a program option that provides the combination of live classroom engagement with parent-determined pacing and assignment adjustments as needed.

Audit status allows the student to go at a pace that promotes success and builds confidence by focusing on learning rather than due dates/deadlines. For a student who is struggling academically or is having difficulty maintaining the homework pace, eliminating the pressure of grades and due dates can encourage progress that often leads to success as a regular status student.



What is Audit Status?

A student on audit status may attend live class or watch the recorded lessons as convenient and may choose to submit any of the auto-graded work in Canvas as desired. Any written work may be completed offline and reviewed independently by the parent or other designated adult.

The parent and child may also choose to turn in any written work to be graded by FPA staff if submitted within the identified due dates.

He or she may also choose to not submit any work, thus being free of any due dates for assigned homework. It is up to the parent or designee to correct and grade the child's written homework on audit status unless submitted within the due dates. It is the parent's or designee's responsibility to keep a record of the grades and to fulfill all state reporting requirements.

The final grade for the class will show as audit for the school year on FPA's records, and student report cards, and transcripts. This essentially becomes an independent study completed at the child's own pace using FPA's curriculum, lessons, and associated assignments. If the parent intends for the child to enroll on regular status for the next school year, the child will need to take a placement test to ensure that he or she has learned enough to move on to the next grade level or course.



Transcript & Report Cards

FPA provides report cards at the end of each semester. Transcripts are available upon request for all completed courses in junior high and high school and are also posted in the student management system at the conclusion of the school year. FPA will issue ONE official transcript to each family. Upon request, FPA will send an official transcript to any educational institution free of charge. Should a family desire an additional transcript(s) for personal use, they can be ordered for \$10 each through the FPA online store.



Learning & Physical Disability

Parents of students with diagnosed or suspected learning, physical, or other learning challenges or disabilities – past or present – MUST notify FPA at the time of enrolling.

FreedomProject Academy may or may not be the right learning environment for students with disabilities, and there is no way to know for sure unless parents are transparent with FPA staff about conditions from the outset. Failure to disclose the existence and extent of a student's special needs may result in either transferring the student to audit or homeschool status or dismissing the student from FPA.



Grade Promotion

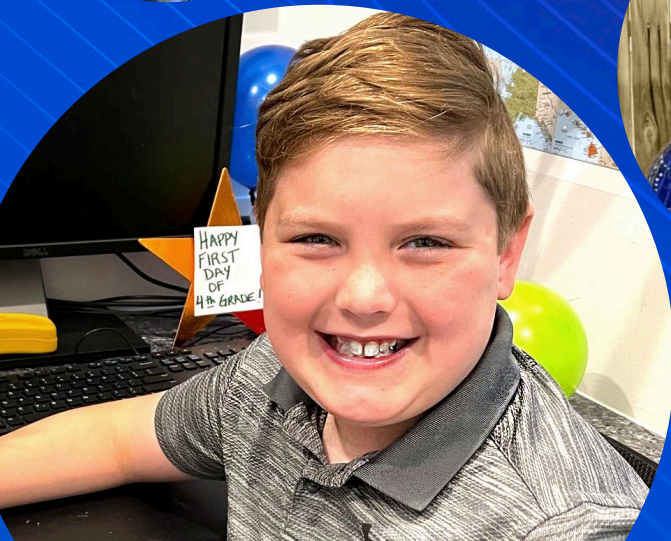
As with any school, students must attain a basic mastery of subject knowledge before moving on to the next level. Elementary students must achieve 65% or higher in all subjects to be promoted to the next level, although 70% is preferred. Students in grades 6 through 12 must have a final grade of 65% or higher in order to pass or earn credit in any course, although 70% is preferred. Students who fail any high school course must retake it if they wish to receive a diploma from FPA. The most recent grade will be included on the transcript and in the GPA calculation.

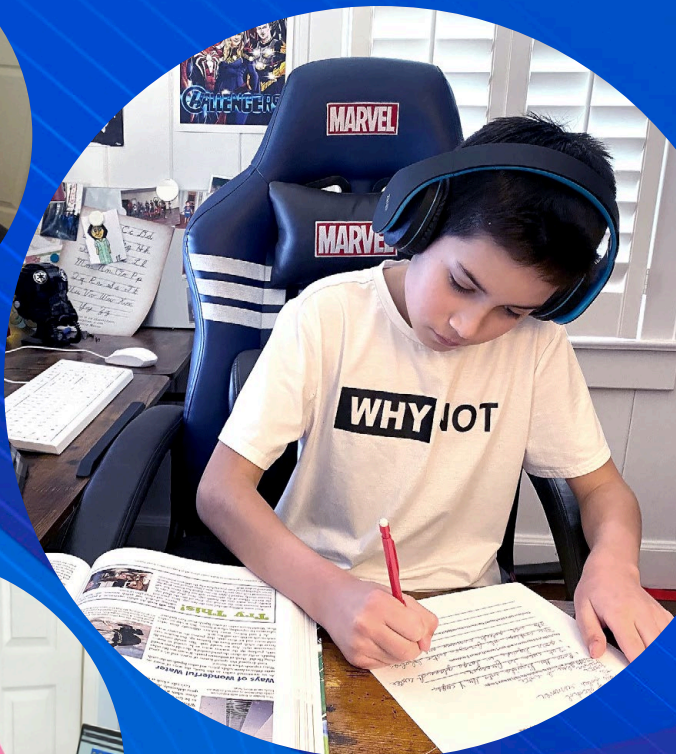


Diploma

- Students entering as freshmen must earn the required 20 credits (including 2 credits of Latin) during their four years of high school in order to qualify to receive a diploma from FPA.
- Students entering as sophomores must earn the required 15 credits (including 1 credit of Latin) during their three years of high school in order to qualify to receive a diploma from FPA.
- Students entering as juniors must earn the required 10 credits during their two years of high school in order to qualify to receive a diploma from FPA.
- Students entering as seniors cannot earn a diploma but will receive a certificate of completion of courses.
- If applying for 9th-11th grades, but placement test results show gaps in academic readiness, students may enroll in a “bridge year” by taking a general English course and a general math course that would allow them to transition to regular courses the following year and work toward a diploma.

NEW STUDENT Enrollment

- Step 1** Visit [FPEUSA.org](https://fpeusa.org) and select **APPLY NOW** to create a parent account and add a child. Complete application in Blackbaud Parent Portal.
- Step 2** Pay \$250 enrollment fee in Smart Tuition family account.
- Step 3** View courses using **Visual Schedule Builder** at fpeusa.org/schedule
- Step 4** Request courses using **COURSE NAME AND SECTION NUMBER** to enroll in preferred sections in Blackbaud Parent Portal.
- Step 5** Based on grade and course selection, student must complete appropriate Placement Test(s).
- Step 6** Review FPA Handbook, Parent Agreement on Expectations, technology requirements, and purchase books needed for courses.
